Breastfeeding advice...

Once you have made the decision to breastfeed, read all you can on the subject plus get tips & advice off family & friends. All this knowledge will give you confidence when starting breastfeeding with your new baby.

Skin to skin contact as soon as possible after birth encourages a strong bond between you and your baby and helps with establishing breastfeeding.

Breastfeeding is a learned experience for your baby and they need to practice to get it right, so in those first few days they are likely to feed more frequently. Make sure you have a comfortable place to feed your baby and put a drink and a snack close by so you can look after your own needs as well as your babies.

Above all don't panic or worry, babies are all individuals and there is no hard and fast rule as to how long it will take to establish a great feeding routine. Always feel you can ask for help and support. Your midwife will be able to provide you with wonderful advice and should you feel you would benefit from further support they can provide you with someone who can offer you one to one support in the comfort of your own home.

Thinking of returning to work?

If you are thinking of returning to work after you've had your baby, lots of help is at hand. You may wish to return to work part time rather than full time, or you may wish to try something new and work out of home. You might be entitled to claim financial support, and you could need to find quality childcare for your baby.

Choosing childcare

By choosing childcare which is registered with Ofsted (Office for Standards in Education, Children's Services and Skills), you know that the childcare provider has been assessed on their suitability to care for children. Registered providers for children under the age of 5 must offer care and early learning to meet the Early Years Foundation Stage framework (EYFS). Providers are inspected before registration and regularly. Registered childcare for infants includes childminders, day nurseries, children's centres and some nannies.

Financial help is generally available for working or studying parents, but there may also be support for lone parents and parents moving into work. Many employers also offer childcare voucher schemes that can save you over £1,000p.a. by allowing you to pay for childcare out of your gross earnings, rather than out of your net take home salary.

It is a bright, vibrant and positive place which provides a home from home environment for children and young adults with life shortening conditions as well as support for the whole family.

Whilst Claire House is a positive place, focussed on helping the children and young adults to get the most out of every day regardless of their ability, their highly specialised Care Team are there also to provide support in the family home, emergency and end of life care when that time comes. Bereavement support is available for as long as it is needed.

Claire House is almost completely reliant on voluntary donations to fund its £2.5 million running costs. With limited funding coming from statutory sources the reality is that they are open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week and 52 weeks a year, but receive funding for just 10 of them.

It is only through the support of people such as yourselves that they are able to continue their vital work.

First Aid tips for parents

Slap it out

1. Lay the baby face down on your forearm supporting the chin.
2. Give up to five back blows between their shoulder blades with the heel of your hand.
3. Look inside the baby's mouth, carefully remove any visible obstructions from the mouth or the nose - DO NOT do a blind finger sweep.

Pump it out

1. If the obstruction has not cleared, turn the baby onto their back.
2. Place two fingers on bottom of the breastbone and push inwards and upwards sharply against their breastbone, up to five times.
3. Check mouth again for any obstructions and carefully remove.



Repeat the back blows and chest thrusts up to 3 times. If the object still has not cleared call 999 or 112 for an ambulance and continue whilst you are waiting for help to arrive.

Apple, Carrot & Cranberry Muffins

Children will love these sweet but not sugary treats. They're perfect for picnics, lunch boxes and after school snacks.

Suitable from: 1 year

Preparation time: 10 minutes Cooking time: 10 minutes

Makes approximately: 24 mini muffins

Ingredients:

200g flour	1 tsp cinnamon
1 tsp baking soda	1 tsp baking powder
75g of cranberries	1 egg
50g of honey	50g vegetable oil
100g grated apple	100g grated carrot
100g of apple puree	

(a pot of baby puree is perfect)

Topping:

200gm of cream cheese
1 tbs of sugar free jam (try St Dalfour or Super Jam)
1 tsp of grated orange zest

Method:

Pre-heat the oven to 180°C.
In a large mixing bowl combine the flour, cinnamon, cranberries, baking soda and baking powder. Combine the egg, oil, honey and apple puree. Stir this mixture into the dry ingredients until just blended. Fold through the grated carrot and apple. Spoon into mini muffin cases. Bake for about 10-12 minutes.
To check they are cooked: a knife tip inserted into a muffin should come out clean.
Leave to cool completely.

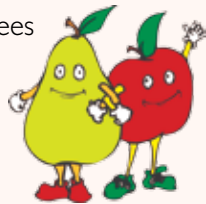
For the topping:

Mix all the ingredients together and spread over the cooled muffins.

Making your own purees is easy to do and it means you know exactly what your baby is eating, plus it can help you save money too.



Cooking fruit & vegetable purees

The easiest way to make your own purees is to wash, peel, chop and then steam whichever fruit or vegetable you're using until it's soft. Take care not to overcook as the food will lose its taste and texture.

Once cooked you can blend it any way you like. You can change the texture by adding a bit of the reserved cooking water or breast milk / formula milk.
